



How to: Figurenotes Fingers

Using Figurenotes fingers you use your own piano, keyboard or xylophone to play Figurenotes Music at home! Here's a helpful guide of how to use Figurenotes fingers.

- 1. Download the Figurenotes Fingers pdf.
- 2. Print this pdf.
- 3. Cut out the Fingers, following the black lines. Ask an adult for help before doing this!
- 4. Find the C key.
 - a. First find the set of two black keys that are close together. Not the set of three!
 - b. Then find the white key to the left of the two black keys.
 - c. This is the C key.



- 5. Place the **Red** on the C note.
 - a. The **X-red** goes on the lowest sounding C. This is the C furthest to the left of the keyboard.
 - b. The **Square-red** goes next, after the X-green.
 - c. The Circle-red after, next to the Square-green
 - d. The **Triangle-red** last, after the Circle-green.
 - e. Use the picture of the keyboard below to help you!
- 6. Stick these in place using something you can later remove, for example bluetac.
- 7. Your keyboard should now look like this!



8. Now you are ready to play!
